AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE 09-06-2022 MOBILE FOOD UNITS

Section 2. Standards and Requirements for Operation.

Yellow highlights are amended additions.

2. In addition to an annual business license, all Mobile Food Unit operators shall obtain an annual operating permit for each unit to be issued by the City of Daleville City Clerk unless otherwise exempted in this Chapter. Permits shall be issued for a specific location and specific dates of operation. This permit shall be posted in a visible location on the Mobile Food Unit at all times while in operation. In order to obtain said permit, operators shall submit copies of all required and current health department approvals for both commissary and each Mobile Food Unit, current City business license and a letter from the property owner stating the physical address, the exact date(s) and hours of operation where permission is being granted.

Red lettering is to be deleted in the amended ordinance.

2. In addition to an annual business license, all Mobile Food Unit operators shall obtain an annual operating permit for each unit to be issued by the City of Daleville City Clerk unless otherwise exempted in this Chapter. Permits shall be issued for the period beginning January 1 and ending December 31 of each year. This permit shall be posted in a visible location on the Mobile Food Unit at all times while in operation. In order to obtain said permit, operators shall submit copies of all required and current health department approvals for both commissary and each Mobile Food Unit and current City business license.
